Identity work that changes one's view of self and the future is so much bigger than simply providing job training and educational support. As 2021 draws to a close, our job-training program is ramping up. December 20-30, we will employ and train 20 East St. Louis students over a 45-hour internship to develop their skills and rehab the historic Katherine Dunham homes.

- Underwriting for R3's mission

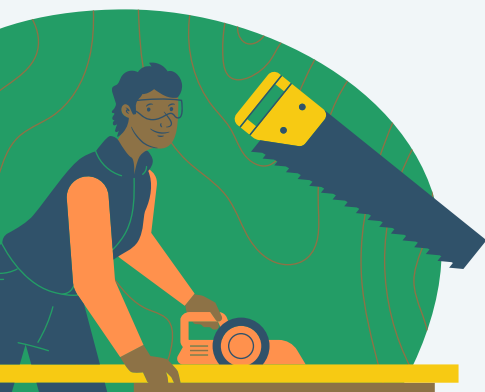
