As we empower them through deep relationships, education, and on-the-job training in construction, we're infusing economic change, not through a handout but a hand up, not by giving them money but by giving them work.

By December 31, our goal is to raise \$150,000 to continue our mission in 2023. By giving, you're helping provide work to more interns. You can give tools, money or host a fundraising campaign at work, church, or in your community.

- **Weekly youth employment** - We've increased youth on-the-job training opportunities by an additional 18 hours per month (additional \$250/month/youth).

- **Outreach to 3 local High Schools** - We are strengthening our pipeline of potential youth entering our program.
- **Housing a displaced family** - We have purchased and are renovating a home for a needy family in our program (\$80,000).
- **Underwriting R3's mission** - We continue the work of combating generational poverty through economic and workforce development efforts that will change the trajectory of our families for generations to come.
